

2024 Percussion Applicant Guide

How to apply:

To apply for the orchestra program, applicants will upload a video audition consisting of the components listed below. Audition videos should have the applicant's entire playing area shown (including hands, torso, playing area of instrument, etc.) You may pause or stop the recording between elements or cut/splice takes, but the audition video must be submitted as a single file.

1. Solo Piece for Two- or Four-Mallet Marimba of Applicant's Choice

A variety of repertoire is acceptable and applicants should select a piece they are comfortable playing.

- Work of applicant's choice that demonstrates overall musicianship
- Maximum of one minute in length
- Must provide a copy of the selected work for the audition
- Does NOT have to be memorized
- No accompaniment

2. Selected Snare Excerpt

3. Selected Timpani Excerpt

Twenty Studies for Timpani by Jaques Delecluse

Pg. 7-8, #6, mm. 30-57

Evaluation Criteria:

PLEASE NOTE: OSAI audition scores may be used to determine chamber music or orchestra part assignments, so prepare for the OSAI audition accordingly.

Marimba solo – 15% Snare excerpt – 15% Timpani excerpt – 15% Overall tone, technique, and rhythm – 55%

It is advisable to learn this piece with twelve beats to the measure, practicing it with four beats to the measure when it has been mastered. The extreme dynamic changes in lines 9 and 10 should be slightly exaggerated.
